- Make sure all worship services, rehearsals, and special events are prepared, staffed, and executed with excellence.
- Develop both paid and volunteer teams, including recruitment, training, scheduling, ministry relations, leadership development, appreciation, and database management.
- Serve as direct staff advisor to production teams and equipment.
- Successfully manage worship/production budget.
- Work with the team leads, providing oversight for all music & tech equipment in distributed systems on the campus.
- Be a key contributor on the Grace staff team.
